

KINDERGARTEN



Using the Saxon Phonics Program, children will be introduced to all letters of the alphabet and their sounds. Students will have an opportunity to work at their level and participate in small group activities to strengthen their emergent reading skills. Students will also learn sight word vocabulary to prepare for first grade.

The math program is also with Saxon publishers. Students use manipulatives to learn basic concepts. Children will order numbers, work on one-to-one correspondence, learn about coins, make patterns and act out story problems.

In Kindergarten, the child will learn the basic D'Nealian handwriting strokes and practice making all the capital and lowercase letters and numbers.

Many Science, Social Studies and Health themes are covered as presentations. Art processes are often times part of projects. Following directions is what matters most, not just the product.

Students will have daily Religion classes with Mass on Wednesdays. Learning prayers and participating in service projects extends our faith into the community and our world.

Kindergarten includes the Standards determined by the State of Colorado. Many activities help to build a strong foundation for life long learning.
